3. DAVID<sup>3</sup> IRISH (John<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>) b about 1673, d Mar 1748 in LC. Res: LC. He m 4 Jan 1699 in LC MARTHA NELSON, d 15 Feb 1760 in LC. They lived on the Irish place opposite the Friend's Meeting House.

His will, recorded in LC Probate book 1, page 30 and proved 3 May 1748: "To wife Martha use of the southwest room in my dwelling house. To son John all my land and meadows with ye buildings lying in LC and Tiverton and all rights divided and undivided. To son William all rights to land in Pine Island lying on the southward end of my farm in Rochester and 20 acres upland with housing. To children Jonathan, Elizabeth and David...to son John 200 acres of upland in Rochester farm and my broad ax that I had of my father. To three daus Priscilla Hiller, Ruth Brownell and Content Gifford..."

Her will, recorded in book 1 page 271, made 20 June 1757 and proved 1 Apr 1760: "To son John of LC my farming utensils, loom and all tackling. To son William of Rochester...to daus Priscilla Hiller, Content Gifford all household goods. To grandson Thomas Irish all things I left to him to keep house with and also my trammell. To son-in-law Joseph Gifford of Dartmouth to be executor..."

4. JONATHAN<sup>3</sup> IRISH (Josh<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>) b 3 June 1678 in LC, d there in 1732. He m about 1702 MARY TAYLOR, dau of John and Abigail Taylor, b 25 Oct 1682 in LC.

Inventory of his estate taken in Taunton 31 Aug 1732: housing and land in LC and Tiverton. Total 1710-10-0.

Her will, recorded in Taunton Probate, book 10, page 333, made 13 May 1743 and proved 30 Sept 1734: "To son Jessie 5 shillings. To son Samuel my now riding horse and saddle. To dau Mary Davis 5 shillings. To dau Hannah Vigneron (?) 1- 2 year heifer and calf, iron trammell and kettle, pewter platter. To dau Anny Macy (?) two beds with bedsteads and brass
