

10. CHARLES⁴ IRISH (John³, John², John¹) b 30 May 1723 in LC, d 14 May 1797 in Newport. Res: LC. He was m 18 Oct 1750 in LC by Joseph Wood, justice, to ABIGAIL WOOD, dau of John and Mary (Burgess) Wood, b 10 Nov 1732 in LC.

11. DAVID⁴ IRISH (John³, John², John¹) b 8 June 1737 in LC. He m (1) 27 Nov 1763 in LC by Aaron Wilbor, justice, to SUSANNAH BROWNELL, dau of Samuel and Anna (Cook) Brownell, b 23 July 1742 in LC, d in 1767. He m (2) HANNAH NEGUS, dau of Samuel Negus, d in 1825. They lived opposite the Friend's Meeting House though supposedly not Quakers.

His will, recorded in LC Probate, book 5, page 101, made 9 Apr 1801 and proved 2 Feb 1818: "To wife Hannah use of one half my dwelling house; to son Charles household goods and all real estate after his mother; to wife all notes found in house with her name on them and 1 cow; to dau Susanna Gray 200 dollars; to grandson Cook Irish andirons and my gun; To grandson David Gray my desk; rest and residue to son Charles..."

13. SAMUEL⁴ IRISH (John³, John², John¹) b 21 Jan 1742/3 in LC. Res: LC. He m MARY DAVIS, b in 1745, d 26 Mar 1821.

His will, recorded in LC Probate book 5, page 35, made 28 June 1815 and proved 1 Apr 1816: "To wife Mary all household goods and improvement of south room below and north chamber in which to bake in oven, etc. To s Simeon 20 dollars and one half of household goods. To son John all my real estate and rest and residue. To granddaughter Mary Irish, dau of my son Benjamin Irish, deceased, 5 dollars. To son John to be executor. The family burying ground in the northeast corner of my northeast meadow to remain a burying place forever and not to be sold, but remain there for use of my near relatives..."

14. THOMAS⁵ IRISH (John⁴, David³, John², John¹) b 11 Nov 1734 in LC. Res: LC. He was m 7 Jan 1759 in LC by Joseph Wood, justice to PHEBE CRANDALL.
